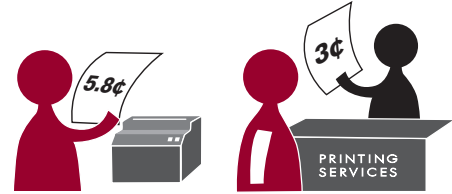




Cost or Convenience? Which Do You Choose?

In the right circumstance, the answer may be **BOTH**.

But you may be surprised to learn how much your department can save by printing larger quantities at Printing Services. The following chart is supplied to help you make a printing choice that both meets your needs and makes responsible use of your department's budget.



Departmental Desktop Printer vs. Printing Services*

Black/White Printing Comparison

8.5 x 11 Black/White	Desktop Printer*	Printing Services Copy Center	Cost Savings	Estimated Yearly Savings
20 copies/prints	\$1.16	\$0.60	\$0.55	\$66.00 (10 jobs/mo.)
50 copies/prints	\$2.90	\$1.50	\$1.40	\$33.60 (2 jobs/mo.)
200 copies/prints	\$11.60	\$6.00	\$5.60	\$67.20 (1 job/mo.)
400 copies/prints	\$23.20	\$12.00	\$11.20	\$67.20 (6 jobs/yr.)
